

GENERAL INFORMATION

Services of the New Hampshire Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory are made available through the cooperative support of the NH Department of Agriculture, Markets & Food and the University of New Hampshire.

Specimens submitted to the laboratory must be referred by practicing veterinarians, state or federal regulatory officials. Fees for services and written case reports are forwarded only to the referring individual.

The laboratory will communicate information regarding reportable diseases directly to appropriate state and federal regulatory officials.

The laboratory is staffed Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Specimens may be delivered in person or via US mail or commercial courier.

Contact the laboratory with questions regarding appropriate selection, preservation, and shipment of specimens.

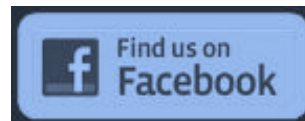
